Did you know that baby wipes may indicate they are flushable, but they should not be put in our wastewater system? This also includes adult wipes, cleaning wipes (Clorox, Lysol, etc.) and toddler wipes. In fact, the only paper product that should be 'flushed' is toilet paper. It is the only paper designed to break down as it travels through the wastewater treatment process. All others were NOT designed to breakdown and thus create problems within the system. They can cause blockages in your home's sewer line that could lead to costly plumber services to repair.
